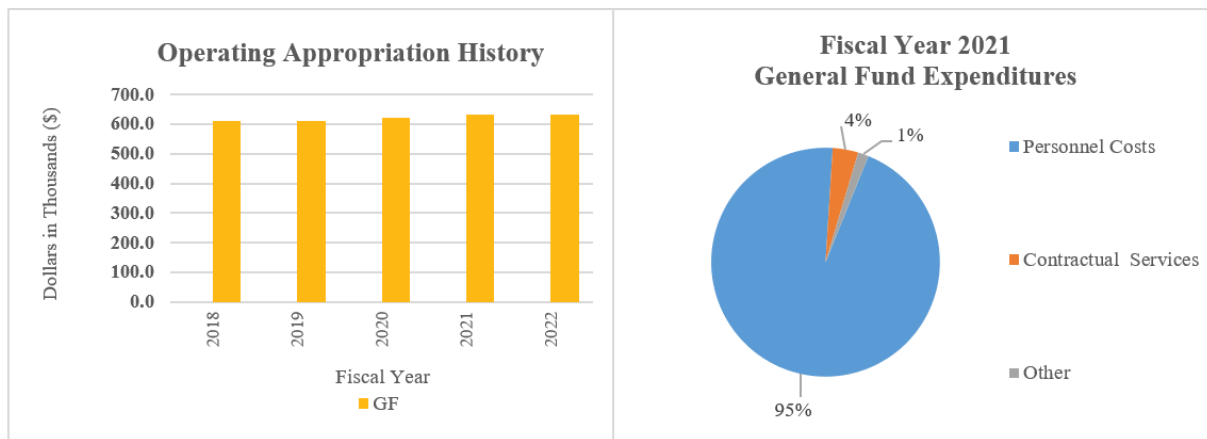


At a Glance

Overview

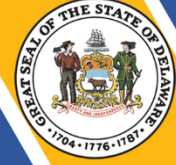
