HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO
HOUSE BILL NO. 121

AMEND House Bill No. 121 by deleting lines 8, 9, and 10 in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“The ~~present~~ boundaries and limits of ~~The the~~ Town of Milton, ~~as set forth in the revised Town map dated January 22, 2008,~~ are hereby established and declared to be, ~~as follows:~~ as set forth in the revised Town Map dated October 3, 2016, which is included as Appendix A and of record in the Recorder of Deeds Office for Sussex County, presently existing and as hereafter amended.”

FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 121 by deleting lines 658, 659, and 610 in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“obedience within the Town limits to the Ordinances of the Town and the laws of the State of Delaware. The police force, under the direction of the Chief of Police, shall have such other duties as the Mayor”.

SYNOPSIS

This amendment clarifies that the territorial limits of the Town of Milton shown on the current Town Map are capable of subsequent amendment through the annexation process. This amendment also removes the extension of the police force’s jurisdiction to enforce the laws of Delaware to within one mile outside of the Town limits.
